### **Community Origins Development Support Proposal**

#### **Objective**

To assist Diaspora in helping development in their former home communities by their own direct funding of community approved projects, linked with a supporting range of development training and 'know how' resources provided for local leaders via the internet, by the Community Development Network

Note: This proposal may require a Diaspora Steering Group,

National Teams and government liaison

#### **BACKGROUND**

The UN University Book (18 professional contributors) titled 'Realizing the Development Potential of Diasporas' features some successful diaspora led intitiaves helping development of their former communities - some in liaison with national governments

#### World Bank Group President David Malpass says:

"....we now estimate that the COVID-19 pandemic is likely to push between 88 and 115 million people into extreme poverty in 2020, setting back poverty reduction by around three years"

A Ten Step process to equip and help disadvantaged communities overseas via UK diaspora has been drafted:








#### DIASPORA COMMUNITY FUNDING
